Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, or national origin in programs & activities receiving Federal financial assistance **(42 U.S.C. Section 2000d)**.

If you believe you have been subjected to discrimination, you may file a complaint with the TUTD Title VI coordinator or the Texas Dept of Transportation, Attn: TxDOT-PTN, 125 E. 11th St, Austin, TX 78701-2483. You may also file complaints directly with the Federal Transit Administration Region 6 Office in Fort Worth (819 Taylor St, Room 8A36, Fort Worth, TX 76102), the U.S. Dept of Transportation Office of Civil Rights (1200 New Jersey Ave, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20590), or with the U.S. Secretary of Transportation (1200 New Jersey Ave, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20590).
